1. DRFA Administration (Provision of supporting evidence)

 Activation of applications • Initial expenditure estimates • Documentation and audit trails • Evidence of event related damage -EXIF metadata, GPS coordinates and time/date taken Records of actual expenditure and repair/replacement activities



3. Asset Condition Assessments (Pre & Post Disaster)

• Undertake surveys to provide evidence of asset condition (pre-disaster) • Allows council to demonstrate damage incurred as a direct result of the disaster

• Queensland Reconstruction Authority may require evidence of natural disaster mitigation strategies in respect of likely or recurring disasters • State assistance may be reduced if councils have not developed and implemented appropriate strategies
